## MAYBE EXTENSION ACTIVITY 1

*Maybe* written by Kobi Yamada and Illustrated by Gabriella Barouch

What you will need:

- Paper
- Something to write with
- Empty container (such as a cleaned out jar or milk carton)
- Help from an older family member who can read

## MAYBE EXTENSION ACTIVITY 2

What you will need:

- Any kind of music even if it is you singing!

Sometimes we fail and fall down - and that is okay!

*"You will get back up and, you will rise a little stronger and a little taller."*

Falling down is part of learning of how you can be better!

*"This world needs your gifts, your talents, your big ideas!"*

Create a dance or movements of how you can try something, fail at it and than get back up again! You can even just mime doing a task like brushing your teeth, learning to tie your shoes, or baking a cake!

Use your imagination and come up with several different moves.

If you are able use music, what kind would match your moves?

Show whoever is in your household your creations - dogs and toys make great audience members!
